One copy of the “PROPOSED Determination” for the Initial Title V Air Operation Permit for the Sumterville Cement Plant located at 4750 E. CR 470, Sumterville, Sumter County, is enclosed. This letter is only a courtesy to inform you that the DRAFT Permit has become a PROPOSED Permit.

Pursuant to Section 403.0872(6), Florida Statutes, if no objection to the PROPOSED Permit is made by the USEPA within 45 days, the PROPOSED permit will become a FINAL Permit on Day 46. Based on the date the PROPOSED permit was posted to USEPA (September 19, 2011), the Day 46 effective date would be November 4, 2011. If USEPA has an objection to the PROPOSED Permit, the FINAL Permit will not be issued until the permitting authority receives written notice that the objection is resolved or withdrawn.

The main purpose of this project is the issuance of the initial Title V Air Operation permit for this Portland cement manufacturing facility.

NOTICE AND PUBLICATION

The Department distributed an Intent to Issue Title V Air Operation Permit package on April 5, 2011. The Department distributed a Revised Written Notice of Intent to Issue Title V Air Operation Permit and Minor Construction Permit package on August 15, 2011. The DRAFT and Revised DRAFT Title V Air Operation Permits were available for public inspection at the permitting authority's office in Temple Terrace. The applicant published the Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permits in the Daily Commercial on August 18, 2011. The Department received the proof of publication on August 26, 2011.

COMMENTS

No comments were received during the 30 (thirty) day public comment period. Since no comments were received, the DRAFT Permit becomes the PROPOSED Permit.

CONCLUSION

In conclusion, no changes were made to the draft permit. The permitting authority hereby issues the PROPOSED Permit, with no changes.
