Request for 30 day Test Trial extension.**

Dear Mr. Koerner,

As of April 11th, 2010 Suwannee American Cement (SAC) has completed 25 days of its Non-Chlorinated Agricultural Plastics test trial as outlined in Permit Number 1210465-020-AC. However, SAC has only consumed 812 short tons of material out of the 1,250 tons of permitted material. Due to limitations presented by the trial equipment, SAC has been experimenting with different techniques to prepare and handle the material to improve the consistency of both the material and its feed rate. At this time, SAC is requesting an additional 30 operating days (operating days - as defined in the construction permit) to continue the test trial and refine the processing techniques to improve this alternative fuel as a viable replacement to fossil fuels.
