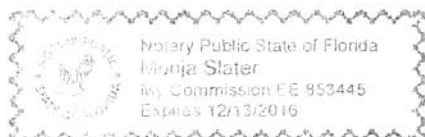

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT  
TO ISSUE AIR PERMIT**  
Florida Department of Environmental  
Protection Division of Air Resource  
Management, Office of Permitting and  
Compliance Draft Minor Source Air  
Permit No. 1210473-001-AC  
Sabal Trail Transmission, LLC,  
Hildreth Compressor Station  
Suwannee County, Florida

**Applicant:** The applicant for this project  
is the Sabal Trail Transmission, LLC. The  
applicant's authorized representative and  
mailing address is: Thomas Wooden,  
Vice President, Field Operations, Spectra  
Energy Corporation, P.O. Box 1642 Hou-  
ston, TX 77251-1642.

**Facility Location:** Sabal Trail Transmis-  
sion, LLC proposes to construct the Hil-  
dreth Compressor Station as part of the  
proposed Sabal Trail natural gas pipeline.  
The proposed compressor station is to be  
located on County Road 49 in Hildreth,  
Suwannee County, Florida.

**Project:** This project is a minor source of  
air pollution. The Hildreth Compressor  
Station will consist of two combustion tur-  
bine compressor engines, one emer-  
gency generator, and natural gas piping  
components. In addition, the station will  
consist of other emission units and sup-  
port equipment to include: two gas-fired  
natural gas heaters; storage tanks and  
vessels; a parts washer; and other mis-  
cellaneous support equipment. Only nat-  
ural gas that contains little or no ash, sul-  
fur, or other contaminants will be fired in  
the compressor turbines which will mini-  
mize emissions of particulate matter and  
sulfur dioxide. The efficient combustion of  
natural gas at high temperatures will re-  
sult in lower emissions of carbon monox-  
ide and volatile organic compounds. Lean  
premix combustion technology will mini-  
mize the formation of nitrogen oxides. Oxid-  
ation catalysts (OxCat) will be used to fur-  
ther reduce emissions of carbon monox-  
ide and volatile organic compounds.

As a minor source of air pollution, a pre-  
construction review under the Prevention  
of Significant Deterioration (PSD) pursu-  
ant to Rule 62-212.400 of the Florida Ad-  
ministrative Code (F.A.C.) is not required.

**Permitting Authority:** Applications for air  
construction permits are subject to re-  
view in accordance with the provisions of  
Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and  
Chapters 62-4, 62-210 and 62-212 of the  
Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The  
proposed project is not exempt from air  
permitting requirements and an air permit  
is required to perform the proposed work.  
The Permitting Authority responsible for  
making a permit determination for this  
project is the Office of Permitting and  
Compliance in the Department of Environ-  
mental Protection's Division of Air Re-  
source Management. The Permitting Au-  
thority's physical address is: 2600 Blair

Permitting Authority's mailing address is:

**Project File:** A complete project file is  
available for public inspection during the  
normal business hours of 8:00 a.m. to  
5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (ex-  
cept legal holidays), at the physical ad-  
dress indicated above for the Permitting  
Authority. The complete project file in-  
cludes the Draft Permit, the Technical  
Evaluation and Preliminary Determina-  
tion, the application and information sub-  
mitted by the applicant (exclusive of con-  
fidential records under Section 403.111,  
F.S., if applicable). Interested persons  
may contact the Permitting Authority's  
project engineer for additional informa-

**Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit:**  
The Permitting Authority gives notice of  
its intent to issue an air construction per-  
mit to the applicant for the project de-  
scribed above. The applicant has  
provided reasonable assurance that oper-  
ation of proposed equipment will not ad-  
versely impact air quality and that the  
project will comply with all appropriate  
provisions of Chapters 62-4, 62-204, 62-  
210, 62-212, 62-296 and 62-297, F.A.C.  
The Permitting Authority will issue a Final  
Permit in accordance with the conditions  
of the proposed Draft Permit unless a  
timely petition for an administrative hear-  
ing is filed under Sections 120.569 and  
120.57, F.S. or unless public comment re-  
ceived in accordance with this notice re-  
sults in a different decision or a significant  
change of terms or conditions.

**Comments:** The Permitting Authority will  
accept written comments concerning the  
proposed Draft Permit for a period of 14  
days from the date of publication of the  
Public Notice. Written comments must be  
received by the Permitting Authority by  
close of business (5:00 p.m.) on or be-  
fore the end of this 14-day period. If writ-  
ten comments received result in a signif-  
icant change to the Draft Permit, the Per-  
mitting Authority shall revise the Draft  
Permit and require, if applicable, another  
Public Notice. All comments filed will be  
made available for public inspection.

**Petitions:** A person whose substantial in-  
terests are affected by the proposed per-  
mitting decision may petition for an ad-  
ministrative hearing in accordance with  
Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. Peti-  
tions filed by any persons other than  
those entitled to written notice under Sec-  
tion 120.60(3), F.S., must be filed within  
14 days of publication of the Public No-  
tice or receipt of a written notice, whic-  
ever occurs first. Under Section  
120.60(3), F.S., however, any person who  
asked the Permitting Authority for notice  
of agency action may file a petition within  
14 days of receipt of that notice, regard-  
less of the date of publication. A peti-  
tioner shall mail a copy of the petition to  
the applicant at the address indicated above,  
at the time of filing. A petition for adminis-  
trative hearing must contain the informa-  
tion set forth below and must be filed (re-  
ceived) with the Agency Clerk in the Of-  
fice of General Counsel, 3900 Common-  
wealth Boulevard, MS 35, Tallahassee,  
Florida 32399-3000,  
[Agency.Clerk@dep.state.fl.us](mailto:Agency.Clerk@dep.state.fl.us), before the  
deadline. The failure of any person to file  
a petition within the appropriate time per-  
iod shall constitute a waiver of that per-  
son's right to request an administrative  
determination (hearing) under Sec-  
tions 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to in-  
tervene in this proceeding and participate  
as a party to it. Any subsequent interven-  
tion (in a proceeding initiated by another  
party) will be only at the approval of the  
presiding officer upon the filing of a mo-  
tion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205,  
F.A.C.

A petition that disputes the material facts  
on which the Permitting Authority's action  
is based must contain the following in-  
formation: (a) The name and address of  
each agency affected and each agency's  
file or identification number, if known; (b)  
The name, address, any email address,  
telephone number and any facsimile num-  
ber of the petitioner; the name, address  
any email address, telephone number,  
and any facsimile number of the peti-  
tioner's representative, if any, which shall be  
the address for service purposes during  
the course of the proceeding; and an ex-  
planation of how the petitioner's substan-  
tial interests will be affected by the  
agency determination; (c) A statement of  
when and how each petitioner received  
notice of the agency action or proposed  
decision; (d) A statement of all disputed  
issues of material fact. If there are none,  
the petition must so state; (e) A concise  
statement of the ultimate facts alleged, in-  
cluding the specific facts the petitioner  
contends warrant reversal or modification  
of the agency's proposed action; (f) A

statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action including an explanation of how the alleged facts relate to the specific rules or statutes; and, (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action the petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action. A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Permitting Authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Permitting Authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Permitting Authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

**Mediation:** Mediation is not available in this proceeding.
