The Florida Municipal Power Agency, JEA, Reedy Creek Improvement District, and the City of Tallahassee (collectively, the Participating Utilities) are pleased to jointly file this SCA for the proposed construction and operation of the Taylor Energy Center (TEC or the Project) in Taylor County, Florida. TEC will consist of a nominal 800-megawatt advanced supercritical pulverized coal electric generating unit and associated facilities with state-of-the-art emission and environmental control systems to reliably and cost-effectively generate electric power in an environmentally protective manner. TEC will be located on an approximately 3,000-acre site in east-central Taylor County approximately 5 miles southeast of the city of Perry. In addition, the TEC Project will involve four associated linear facilities located in offsite corridors, including a 5.1-mile, double-circuit, 230-kilovolt transmission line; 2.7-mile railroad spur; potable water supply pipeline; and treated wastewater pipeline. The Participating Utilities are seeking certification of the proposed electric generating facilities and the associated offsite linear corridors within this certification proceeding.

Enclosed are the original and 11 hard copies of the TEC SCA. Each SCA includes an electronic copy on a compact disc in the front of Volume 1. Also enclosed is a check for the application fee of \$200,000.

By copy of this letter, the Participating Utilities are also submitting the original and four copies of the Air Construction/Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) permit application and a check for \$7,500 for the filing fee to the Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Air Regulation. A copy of the full SCA is also being submitted to the Bureau. The SCA includes the PSD permit application as Volume 4.
