
This is to inform the Department per the requirements of Section 112(j) of the Clean Air Act that PRIDE Enterprises (PRIDE), Union Correctional Facility, Route 1 Box 308, Raiford, Florida is a major source of hazardous air pollutants (HAP) affected by 40 CFR 63 Subpart DDDDD, *Industrial, Commercial & Institutional Boilers and Indirect Process Heaters*. PRIDE manufactures metal furniture and automobile license tags. PRIDE permitted by the Department to use 30 tons of xylene per year in the coating processes of the metal furniture and the license tags. The Tag plant has two drying ovens fueled by natural gas. The clearcoat drying oven (EP 05) and the ink drying oven (EP 06). Xylene is used for the thinning of ink and clearcoat and is a component of the ink and coating. The metal Furniture plant has a bake oven (EP 03) fueled by natural gas to dry painted furniture. In addition, this plant also has a natural gas fired boiler used to heat water for cleaning the metal prior to coating. After leaving the washing operation, the furniture passes through a natural gas fired drying oven. The washing operation was listed as an insignificant source on the permit. The two ovens at the Tag plant, the boiler, drying oven and bake oven at the Metal Furniture plant are the other sources that will come under regulation by the proposed MACT. All of the affected sources utilize natural gas. No MACT Determination has been made on any source at the PRIDE facility.

To summarize, the affected emissions units are

1. Two Drying Ovens at the Tag Plant (EP 05 and 06)
2. One Bake Oven at the Metal Furniture Plant (EP 03)
3. One Boiler at the Metal Furniture Plant
4. One Drying Oven at the Metal Furniture Plant

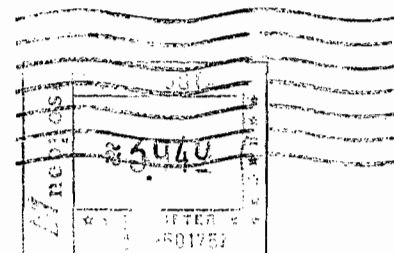


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
