
Respondent, State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection, has no objection to it. Therefore,



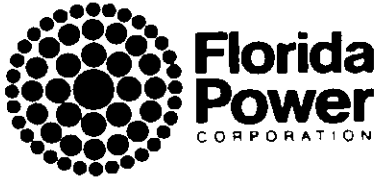

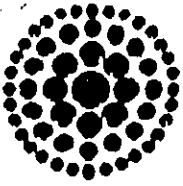
