As your office is aware, our plant is a permitted major source of hazardous air pollutants. Under Section 112(j) of the Clean Air Act Amendments, we are notifying you that our facility *may* have an affected source in a source category (Miscellaneous Metal Parts Surface Coating) for which EPA has not a promulgated standard under 40 CFR 63. The draft standard for Miscellaneous Metal Parts Surface Coating has not been issued, and therefore we cannot make an accurate applicability determination at this time.

The operation is a medical device needle manufacturing plant that contains the following processes: needle lube mixing and application, wet blast and grit blast and electrolytic grinding. These processes are classified as Emission Unit 009.
