Station, which is located at 667 Port Leon Drive, St. Marks, in Wakulla County.

two simple cycle combustion turbines, one auxiliary boiler and a combined cycl

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Notice of Intent to Issue an Air Permit: The Permitting Authority gives notice o
intent to concurrently issue an air construction permit and a Title V air opera
permit renewal to the applicant for the projects described above. The applicant
provided reasonable assurance that operation of the facility will not adversely imp
air quality and that the project will comply with all appropriate provisions of Chap
62-4, 62-204, 62-210, 62-212, 62-213, 62-214,
62-296, and 62-297, F.A.C. The Permitting Authority will issue a proposed Title V
operation permit and subsequent final air construction and Title V air opera
permits in accordance with the conditions of the draft permits unless a resp
received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decisio
a significant change of terms or conditions.

Comments: The Permitting Authority will accept written comments concerning
draft air construction permit for a period of fourteen (14) days from the dat
publication of this Public Notice and will accept comments concerning the draft Tit
air operation permit for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of publication of
Public Notice. Written comments must be post-marked and all e-mail or facsim
comments must be received by the close of business (5 pm), on or before the end of
14-day or 30-day periods by the Permitting Authority at the above address, e-mai
facsimile. As part of his or her comments, any person may also request that
Permitting Authority hold a public meeting on this permitting action. If the Permi
Authority determines there is sufficient interest for a public meeting, it will pub

Petitions: A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permit
decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Secti
120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below
must be filed with (received by) the Department's Agency Clerk in the Office
General Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection at 31
Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #85, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-30
Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Sect
120.60(3), F.S., must be filed within fourteen (14) days of publication of this Pub
Notice or receipt of a written notice, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60
F.S., however, any person who asked the Permitting Authority for notice of age
action may file a petition within fourteen (14) days of receipt of that notice, regard
of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to
applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of a
person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waive
that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Secti
120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a part
it. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will
only at the approval of the permit.
