The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) gives notice of its intent to issue two (2) construction permits to Angelo's Recycled Materials Inc. for a land application proposed possible concrete and asphalt recycled materials that will be processed in a construction and handling area located in Florida. The location is a rather remote area and not subject to the provisions of Significant Reclamation (SR) regulations, Rule 62B32.001, F.A.C. A Best Available Control Technology (BAT) application was not required for this facility. The applicant's current address is: Angelo's Recycled Materials Inc., P.O. Box 1483, Logo, Florida 32079-1483.

The applicant proposes to operate the facility in counties covered by this notice. The units will emit fugitive particulate matter from the products of construction from the dust but air pollution control is accomplished by watering as needed.

Total emissions of particulate from each facility is estimated to be:

Particulate	Monthly Emissions pounds per hour	Annual Emissions tons per year
Particulate Matter (PM10)	2.5	5.5
Organic Gases (OG)	1.5	3.5
Carbon Dioxide (CO2)	1.0	2.1
Sulfur Dioxide (SO2)	1.1	2.5
Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC)	1.1	2.5

Because of the low emissions and limited the operational any one area, the matter will not cause or contribute to any violation of an ambient or quality standard.

The Department affirms the FINAL Permit, in accordance with the conditions of the DRAFT Permit unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant changed terms of conditions.

The Department will accept written comments concerning the proposed DRAFT Permit issuance on or before a period of 14 (fourteen) days from the date of publication of this notice. Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation, 2820 Bay Boulevard, Suite 2000, Bay Pines, Florida 33982-3000. Any written comments that shall be considered for public release will be made available to the public. If written comments received result in a significant change to these DRAFT Permits, the Department shall issue Revised DRAFT Permits and re-evaluate, if applicable, whether a Public Hearing is warranted.

The Department will issue the FINAL Permit with the conditions of the DRAFT Permit unless a public hearing is held. The Department will schedule a public hearing if requested by the applicant or if the Department determines that a public hearing is warranted. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the department's proposed permit this decision may petition for an administrative proceeding. Such petition is appropriate only if: Section 228.005 and 228.007, Florida Statutes, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed in the Office of Administrative Hearings of the Department, 2820 Bay Boulevard, Suite 2000, Bay Pines, Florida 33982-3000, telephone 813-292-6200, fax 813-292-6200. Petitions must be filed within fifteen (15) days of publication of the notice with fourteen (14) days of receipt of the notice of intent. Petitions occur late. The intent of this notice is to be a petition which the Department may or may not conduct a hearing of the permit subject to repeat consideration. The Department (Agency) under Sections 228.005 and 228.007, F.S. is to determine if the proposed permit is a public hearing. Any subsequent transactions will be only at the option of the petitioner after upon the filing of a motion compliance with Rule 68.007 of the Florida Administrative Code.

A petition must contain the following information: (a) Name, address and telephone number of each petitioner; (b) The applicant's name and address, the Permit File Number and the county in which the project is proposed; (c) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the department's notice or proposal action; (d) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the department's notice or proposal action; (e) A statement of the individual facts alleged by the petitioner; (f) A statement of how the petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the department's notice or proposal action; (g) A statement identifying the law or statute that the petitioner contends applies to the proposed action or modification of the department's action or proposal action; and (h) A statement of the petitioner's proposed action or modification of the department's action or proposal action. The Department will take no action on the petitioner's petition or proposal action if the petitioner fails to file a petition.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to facilitate that agency action, the filing of a petition does not prevent the Department's action. Petitioner may be informed from the position taken by it in the notice of intent. Petitioner's substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department and the petitioner has the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding. In accordance with the requirements of law.
