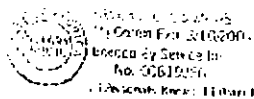

Notice of Intent to issue an air construction permit to Angelo's Recycled Materials, Inc. for a diesel engine powered portable generator and diesel engine generator set to be operated in construction and industrial use throughout Florida. The generator is a minor source of air pollution and is exempt from the provisions of Significant Emissions (SE) regulations, Rule 62-218.400, F.A.C. A Best Available Control Technology determination was not required for this facility. The applicant's name and address are Angelo's Recycled Materials, Inc., P.O. Box 1483, Largo, Florida 32779-4833.

The applicant proposes to operate the facility in accordance with the permit. The permit shall require the permittee to install and maintain the generator set in accordance with the best available control technology emission control from the generator set. The permit shall also require the permittee to install and maintain the generator set in accordance with the best available control technology emission control from the generator set. Total annual emissions from the facility are estimated to be:

The Department will issue the Final Air Construction Permit in accordance with the conditions of the Draft Permit unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different action or significant change of terms or conditions.

The Department will accept written comments concerning the proposed Draft Permit, subject to a period of 30 days from the date of the public notice of publication of the Notice. Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station 45975, Tallahassee, Florida 32309-2400. Any written comments filed shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments are received in a significant change in these Draft Permit, the Department shall issue Revised Draft Permits and a Request for Public Hearing.

To begin the Final Air Construction Permit with the conditions of the Draft Permit, unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. Mediation is not available for the action. The procedure for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petitioner must furnish the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department, 3600 Commonwealth Boulevard Mail Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32309-3000, telephone: 904-486-8170, fax: 904-487-4903. Petitions must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of release of this notice of intent, whichever occurs first. A petitioner must mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the applicable time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be confined to the subject matter of the petition filed upon the filing of a motion to comply with Rule 28-6.22, F.A.C.

A petition must contain the following information: (a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner; the applicant's name, full address, the Permit File Number and the county in which the project is proposed; (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action; (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action; (d) A statement of the material facts disputed by petitioner; (e) A statement of the facts that the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; (f) A statement identifying the laws or statutes that the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating in separate paragraphs the petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the Department's action or proposed action addressed in this notice of intent.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate the agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the petition taken by it in the notice of intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department or the applicant have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding.
