#### FINAL DETERMINATION

Ranger Construction Industries, Inc. Permit No. 7770253-002-AC

The Intent to Issue an air construction permit to Ranger Construction Industries, Inc. for a portable Astec 150 TPH recyclable asphalt plant was distributed on December 5, 1995. The Notice of Intent to Issue was published in the Palm Beach Post on December 12, 1995, the Orlando Sentinel on January 9, 1996, and the Ledger on January 11, 1996. Copies of the evaluation were available for public inspection at all District and County air pollution program offices in Florida.

Comments were submitted by the permitting engineers in the Northwest District and the Palm Beach County Health Department. Their comments and the Bureau of Air Regulation responses are presented below.

- 1. The permit number should end in "AC" for air construction instead of "AO" for air operation. The Bureau agrees and has made this change to the permit number.
- 2. If the construction permit was valid for 5 years, it would simplify amendments to the applicable permits authorizing operation at new sites. The Department issues construction permits for the estimated time needed to construct, startup and test the unit as well as process the operating permit. The Department does not want a facility to operate commercially for an extended length of time under the authority of the construction permit. An operation permit is generally issued for the maximum of 5 years as allowed by Rule 62-4.070, F.A.C. The Bureau will process the application for permit to operate this portable unit because it is used in different Districts. The Bureau will also process any amendments to the permits for this unit.
- 3. Clarify the visible emission standard for the unit. Specific Condition No. 4 is reworded to be consistent with the air regulations. Visible emissions must be less than 20 percent opacity. A visible emission of 20 percent opacity would violate the regulations and this permit.
- 4. Is the unit subject to 40 CFR 60, Subpart 000, new source performance standards (NSPS) for nonmetallic mineral processing plants? This portable unit is not subject to this NSPS because its capacity is 150 TPH or less.
- 5. A limit on the sulfur dioxide emissions for this unit was requested so that it can be determined if a stationary facility

served by this portable unit will become subject to additional regulations. Sulfur dioxide emissions from this unit, when using a maximum of 14 GPH of diesel fuel containing a 0.5 percent sulfur, are calculated to be 1.0 lbs/hr and 1 ton per year for 2080 hrs/yr operation. A limit on consumption rate and sulfur content of the diesel fuel is added to Specific Condition No. 2.

The final action of the Department will be to issue the construction permit as proposed except for the changes noted above.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. The terms, conditions, requirements, limitations, and restrictions set forth in this permit are "Permit Conditions" and are binding and enforceable pursuant to Sections 403.161, 403.727, or 403.859 through 403.861, F.S. The permittee is placed on notice that the Department will review this permit periodically and may initiate enforcement action for any violation of these conditions.

- 2. This permit is valid only for the specific processes and operations applied for and indicated in the approved drawings or exhibits. Any unauthorized deviation from the approved drawings, exhibits, specifications, or conditions of this permit may constitute grounds for revocation and enforcement action by the Department.
- 3. As provided in Subsections 403.087(6) and 403.722(5), F.S., the issuance of this permit does not convey any vested rights or any exclusive privileges. Neither does it authorize any injury to public or private property or any invasion of personal rights, nor any infringement of federal, state or local laws or regulations. This permit is not a waiver of or approval of any other Department permit that may be required for other aspects of the total project which are not addressed in the permit.
- 4. This permit conveys no title to land or water, does not constitute State recognition or acknowledgement of title, and does not constitute authority for the use of submerged lands unless herein provided and the necessary title or leasehold interests have been obtained from the State. Only the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund may express State opinion as to title.
- 5. This permit does not relieve the permittee from liability for harm or injury to human health or welfare, animal, or plant life, or property caused by the construction or operation of this permitted source, or from penalties therefore; nor does it allow the permittee to cause pollution in contravention of F.S. and Department rules, unless specifically authorized by an order from the Department.
- 6. The permittee shall properly operate and maintain the facility and systems of treatment and control (and related appurtenances) that are installed or used by the permittee to achieve compliance with the conditions of this permit, as required by Department rules. This provision includes the operation of backup or auxiliary facilities or similar systems when necessary to achieve compliance with the conditions of the permit and when required by Department rules.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS:

7. The permittee, by accepting this permit, specifically agrees to allow authorized Department personnel, upon presentation of credentials or other documents as may be required by law and at a reasonable time, access to the premises, where the permitted activity is located or conducted to:

- a. Have access to and copy any records that must be kept under the conditions of the permit;
- b. Inspect the facility, equipment, practices, or operations regulated or required under this permit; and,
- c. Sample or monitor any substances or parameters at any location reasonably necessary to assure compliance with this permit or Department rules.

Reasonable time may depend on the nature of the concern being investigated.

- 8. If, for any reason, the permittee does not comply with or will be unable to comply with any condition or limitation specified in this permit, the permittee shall immediately provide the Department with the following information:
  - a. A description of and cause of non-compliance; and,
  - b. The period of noncompliance, including dates and times; or, if not corrected, the anticipated time the non-compliance is expected to continue, and steps being taken to reduce, eliminate, and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance.

The permittee shall be responsible for any and all damages which may result and may be subject to enforcement action by the Department for penalties or for revocation of this permit.

9. In accepting this permit, the permittee understands and agrees that all records, notes, monitoring data and other information relating to the construction or operation of this permitted source which are submitted to the Department may be used by the Department as evidence in any enforcement case involving the permitted source arising under the F.S. or Department rules, except where such use is prescribed by Sections 403.73 and 403.111, F.S. Such evidence shall only be used to the extent it is consistent with the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure and appropriate evidentiary rules.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS:

10. The permittee agrees to comply with changes in Department rules and F.S. after a reasonable time for compliance, provided, however, the permittee does not waive any other rights granted by F.S. or Department rules.

- 11. This permit is transferable only upon Department approval in accordance with Rules 62-4.120, F.A.C., as applicable. The permittee shall be liable for any non-compliance of the permitted activity until the transfer is approved by the Department.
- 12. This permit or a copy thereof shall be kept at the work site of the permitted activity.
- 13. The permittee shall comply with the following:
  - a. Upon request, the permittee shall furnish all records and plans required under Department rules. During enforcement actions, the retention period for all records will be extended automatically unless otherwise stipulated by the Department.
  - b. The permittee shall hold at the facility or other location designated by this permit records of all monitoring information (including all calibration and maintenance records and all original strip chart recordings for continuous monitoring instrumentation) required by the permit, copies of all reports required by this permit, and records of all data used to complete the application for this permit. These materials shall be retained at least three years from the date of the sample, measurement, report, or application unless otherwise specified by Department rule.
  - c. Records of monitoring information shall include:
  - the date, exact place, and time of sampling or measurements;
  - the person responsible for performing the sampling or measurements;
  - the dates analyses were performed;
  - the person responsible for performing the analyses;
  - the analytical techniques or methods used; and,
  - the results of such analyses.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS:

14. When requested by the Department, the permittee shall within a reasonable time furnish any information required by law which is needed to determine compliance with the permit. If the permittee becomes aware that relevant facts were not submitted or were incorrect in the permit application or in any report to the Department, such facts or information shall be corrected promptly.

#### SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:

- 1. The construction and operation of this facility shall reasonably conform to the plan submitted in the application. No alterations shall be made to the facility that has the potential to increase air pollutant emissions without prior written approval from the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation.
- 2. The plant may operate up to 2,080 hrs/year. The permittee shall maintain a log showing the locations, dates, hours of operation, fuel consumption, fuel sulfur content (certified analysis from fuel supplier), water usage to control fugitive dust, and production of this plant. The maximum process feed rate of this plant shall be less than 150 TPH. Maximum diesel fuel consumption and sulfur content shall not exceed 14 GPH and 0.5 percent, respectively. The permittee shall provide a means of monitoring the fuel and feed rate to insure compliance with this requirement.
- 3. Visible emissions from the asphalt crusher plant shall not exceed 5% opacity.
- 4. Visible emissions from the diesel engine must be less than 20% opacity pursuant to Rule 62-296.310(2),F.A.C.
- 5. Compliance with Specific Conditions Nos. 3 and 4 shall be demonstrated using EPA Reference Method 9 as described in 40 CFR 60, Appendix A. Such tests shall be conducted within 45 days of completion of construction and initial operation at a site in Florida. Visible emissions tests (minimum of 30 minutes) shall be conducted annually thereafter, provided the plant operates at the same site for a year. Each time this plant moves to any of the other approved sites, a visible emissions test shall be conducted within 15 days of any such move and annually thereafter, provided the plant operates at this site for a year. Any water usage for dust control, at which compliance with the 5% visible emissions standard is demonstrated, shall be included on the test report.

#### SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:

6. The permittee shall provide a written notification at least 15 days prior to any compliance testing to the appropriate agency (Department District office and County Air Pollution Control Agency), in accordance with Rule 62-297.340(1), F.A.C.

- 7. This plant shall be allowed to operate throughout the State of Florida (all counties) provided:
- At least 7-days prior to relocating the plant, the permittee shall notify the air program administrator for the Department's District and, if applicable, County Air Pollution Control Agency, of the approved site(s) that the plant may be operated at. The notification shall be on DEP Form 62-210.900(3), F.A.C. All potential construction sites may be shown on a USGS topographic map. Unless notified otherwise by an environmental agency, the plant may be relocated and operated at any site on the list.
- (b) The duration of emissions of this facility at the new location shall not exceed two years.
- (c) The applicant must obtain a "Notice of Intent" for <u>each</u> new location, if other than an appoved site authorized by this permit, from the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation for publication in the legal ad section of a newspaper of general circulation in the area affected, in accordance with Rule 62-210.350, F.A.C. The applicant shall provide a certified copy of the proof of publication to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation.
- (d) After the 14 day comment period has expired and if an administrative hearing has not been requested, the applicant shall obtain an amendment to the permit identifying the new location prior to beginning operation at the new location.
- (e) Only one public notice is required for operating at a specific location. The permittee must give at least 7 days notice to the appropriate County Air Pollution Control Program and the Department District's office prior to relocating the plant to any other location pursuant to Rule 62-210.900(3), F.A.C. The permittee shall identify the new location and duration of operation in the notice.

#### SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:

(f) This plant shall not be operated in a location or in a manner that creates a nuisance.

- (g) Issuance of this permit does not relieve the permittee from complying with applicable emission limiting standards or other requirements of Chapter 62-296 and 62-297, F.A.C., or any other requirements under federal, state or local regulations.

In response to your letter of October 18, we submit the following information.

- 1. No permit was ever applied for to construct this unit. This is a portable unit and could be set up, operated to crush material and moved again in a matter of days. This unit came complete from the factory ready to use.
- 2. There has not been a visual emission test done on this unit.
- 3. There should be no particulate emissions emitted from this unit under normal circumstances. The material being crushed contains 5 to 6% liquid asphalt in addition to the 2 to 6% moisture contained in this material. If the area in which the crusher is operating becomes dusty, this area would be sprayed with water.

- 4. Estimate of the particulate matter emitted from the crusher unit in pounds per hour or tons per year is a non-detectible amount.
- 5. Diesel engine used to power the unit is a Cat 3408 rated @402 continuous HP at 1800 rpm. The fuel consumption is rated at 11 to 14 gallons per hour. Caterpillar Inc. Specifications indicate this engine will produce 0.625 pounds of particulate matter per hour of operation. Based on a 7 hour day, 240 days per year, particulate matter per year would be 0.525 tons.
- 6. Specific sites of operation are: 95th Ave. Royal Palm Beach, Palm Beach County Florida; 4510 Glades Cut-Off Road, Ft. Pierce, St. Lucie County, Florida; 4210 Old Dixie Highway, Grant, Brevard County Florida; 2600 SR 60 West, Bartow, Polk County Florida; 18300 NW 122 Ave, Miami (Medley), Dade County Florida and 2501 NW 48th Street, Pompano Beach, Broward County Florida. This is a listing of the locations the crusher presently services. This list could change in the future depending upon need. In any event, the unit will only be operated at asphalt plants and road/parking lot replacement projects.
- 7. General plot plan for the crusher unit is attached.



I have enclosed a copy of that rule and am requesting that our current operating permit # 099-0087-002-AO be revised to include the conditions included in that rule. In essence, we are agreeing to operate our asphalt plant in accordance with those conditions.

BEST AVAILABLE COPY LCL Conditional Exemptions From Title V Air Permitting.

the following facilities are exempt from the requirement to obtain a Title V air operation permit under the provisions of Chapter 62-211. F.A.C... but are not exempt from the requirement to obtain any other air permit as may be required by this rule. A facility is not entitled to an exemption under this rule if it is a Title V source pursuant to paragraph [f] or [g] of the definition of "major source of air pollution" at Rule 62-211.200. F.A.C.. or if it contains other emissions units which would cause the facility to be classified as a Title V source as a result of their combined potential to emit regulated pollutants.

1. Asphalt\_concrete\_plants.\_provided\_the\_following conditions\_are\_met:

a. The production rate of asphaltic concrete shall not exceed 500,000 tons in any consecutive twelve-month period.

If the facility is not subject to Subpart I. it shall not exceed the applicable particulate emission limiting standard pursuant to Rule 62-296.310(1). F.A.C., and its hours of operation shall not exceed 1.000 hours in any consecutive twelve-month period.

f. Visible emissions (VE) shall not be equal to or greater than 20 percent opacity.

If such facility has a valid air operation permit, the permit will be updated by the Department to incorporate the requirements of Rule 62210, 100(3)(c)1.a. through i... F.A.C.. If such facility does not have a valid air operation permit, the facility shall apply to

the Department for an air operation permit not later than March 15, 1996.

k. The owner or operator of any asphalt plant which commences operation after January 1, 1996, must request that the requirements of Rule 62-210.300(3)(c)1, a. through i. F.A.C., be incorporated into the facility's air operation permit.

#### I. GENERAL INFORMATION

## A. Applicant

#### B. Request

On October 6, 1995, Ranger Construction Industries, Inc., submitted an application for permit to construct/operate a portable Astec 150 TPH Recyclable Asphalt Crusher plant (SIC 3272) in Florida. The application was considered complete on November 3, 1995.

#### C. Process

This portable recyclable asphalt crusher plant reclaims used asphalt paving by reducing it's size to allow it to be reprocessed in a hot mix asphalt plant. Major components of the recyclable asphalt crusher plant are a hopper, crusher, screen, conveyors and a diesel powered electric generator.

Used asphalt is placed in a hopper/conveyor by a payloader or similar equipment. The asphalt passes through a crusher onto a belt conveyor. The crushed asphalt then passes through a screen. The oversized asphalt is returned by a belt conveyor to the crusher. The proper size asphalt is transferred to a storage pile or truck by a separate belt conveyor.

#### D. Emissions

Particulate matter (PM) and products of combustion from the diesel engine are emitted from this plant.

The unconfined PM emissions from the material handling of the asphalt are controlled by water sprays.

The diesel engine will consume up to 14 gallons per hour of diesel fuel. The estimated emissions from the diesel engine are 0.01 lb/hr PM, 0.5 lb/hr sulfur oxides, 3.7 lbs/hr nitrogen oxides, and 9.2 lbs/hr carbon monoxide.

#### II. Rule Applicability

The proposed project, construction of a portable 150 TPH recyclable asphalt crusher plant, is subject to preconstruction

review under the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes, and Chapters 62-4, 62-210, 62-212, 62-272, 62-296, and 62-297, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).

The plant may be operated in areas designated attainment for all criteria air pollutants (Rule 62-275.400, F.A.C.), nonattainment for ozone and PM (Rule 62-275.410, F.A.C.), unclassified for  $PM_{10}$  and sulfur dioxide (Rule 62-275.420, F.A.C.), and maintenance for ozone (Rule 62-275.600, F.A.C.).

The plant is a minor source for all regulated air pollutants. The plant is not subject to the Reasonably Available Control Technology (RACT) limits for PM because allowable emissions are less than 5 lbs/hr and 15 TPY (Rule 62-296.700(2), F.A.C.).

The plant is subject to Rule 62-212.300, F.A.C., which pertains to sources not subject to the Prevention of Significant Deterioration or nonattainment review. The plant is subject to the Unconfined Emissions of PM regulations, Rule 62-296.310(3), F.A.C. The plant is subject to the Notification of Intent to Relocate requirements in Rule 62-210.900(3), F.A.C.

#### III. Technical Evaluation

Loading of the hopper, storage, processing and transfer of the asphalt material, and operation of the diesel engine have the potential to emit air pollutants.

Reasonable precautions, such as water spray, are used to control unconfined emissions of particulate matter.

### IV. Ambient Air Impact

The low emissions from this portable plant will not have a significant impact on the ambient air quality.

#### V. Conclusion

Based on the information provided by Ranger Construction Industries, Inc., the Department has reasonable assurance that the proposed operation of the portable 150 TPH recyclable asphalt crusher plant, as described in this evaluation, and subject to the conditions proposed herein, will not cause or contribute to a violation of any air quality standard, or any other technical provision of Chapters 62-212 and 62-4 of the Florida Administrative Code.


