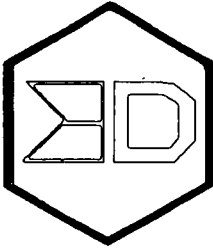

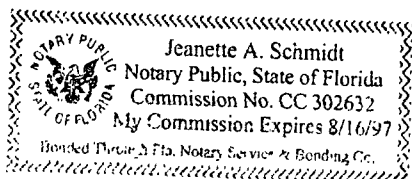

 NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE PERMIT

The Department of Environmental Protection gives notice of its intent to issue an air pollution permit (No. AC60-275111) to Dixie Lime and Stone Co. for the after-the-fact construction of an existing limestone processing plant and the construction of a new portable screening operation at its facility located at the Sumterville Mine, Highway 470, Sumterville, Florida. MAILING ADDRESS - Dixie Lime and Stone Co., P.O. Box 1209, Anthony, Florida 32617 to the attention of Mr. Joseph M. Stavola.

A Best Available Control Technology (BACT) determination was not required.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by this proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative determination (hearing) in accordance with Section 120.57, Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400, within 14 days of publication of this notice. Petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. Failure to petition within this time period shall constitute a waiver of any right such person may have to request an administrative determination (hearing) under section 120.57, Florida Statutes.

The Petition shall contain the following information:

- (a) The name, address, and the telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the Department Permit File Number and the county in which the project is proposed.
- (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action;
- (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action;
- (d) A statement of the material facts disputed by petitioner, if any;
- (e) A statement of facts which petitioner contends warrants reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action;
- (f) A statement of which rules or statutes petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and
- (g) A statement of the relief sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the Department's action or proposed action.

If a petition is filed, the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate agency action. Accordingly, the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this permit. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any decision of the Department with regard to the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding. The petition must conform to the requirements specified above and be filed (received) within 14 days of receipt of this notice, in the Office of General Counsel at the above address of the Department. Failure to petition within the allotted time frame constitutes a waiver of any rights such person has to request a hearing under Section 120.57, F.S., and to participate as a party to this proceeding. Any subsequent intervention will only be at the approval of the presiding officer upon motion filed pursuant to Rule 28-5.207, F.A.C.

The application is available for public inspection during normal business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays, at 8407 Laurel Fair Circle, Tampa, Florida 33610.
