A Best Available Control Technology (BACT) determination was not required for any air pollution pursuant to Rule 61.002, F.A.C. Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD). The units will be operated near construction sites requiring ready mix concrete in counties covered by this notice. Maximum particulate matter emissions from the two largest plants (200 cubic yard per hour) are estimated to be 12.4 pounds per hour (PPH) and 21.9 lbs per year (PY) each. Maximum particulate matter emissions from two other plants (100 cubic yard per hour) are estimated to be 6.2 pounds per hour (PPH) and 24.6 lbs per year (PY) each. Maximum particulate matter emissions from the two plants (100 cubic yard) are estimated to be 6.2 PPH and 17.0 PY. The particulate and dust will come from the products of construction from their use. A Best Available Control Technology (BACT) determination was not required for any air pollutant pursuant to Rule 62-312.005 F.A.C. Pursuant to Section 62-312.005 F.A.C., the units will be operated near construction sites requiring ready mix concrete in counties covered by this notice.

Maximum particulate matter emissions from the 14 largest plants (366 cubic yards/hour production) are estimated to be 12.4 pounds per hour (lb/hr) and 24.9 tons per year (TPY) each. Maximum particulate matter emissions from two other plants (22 cubic yards/hour production) are estimated to be 6.2 pounds per hour (lb/hr) and 24.9 TPY each. Maximum particulate matter emissions from the last plant (12 cubic yards/hour production) are estimated to be 1.6 lb/hr and 7.8 TPY. The polluting trucks will not be powered by combustion from their fuel. The plants will not be a source of any other air pollutants.

Because of the low emissions and the limited time (1 year) of operation of any one site (1 year), the emissions from these units will not cause air quality violations of the ambient air quality standards. An air quality impact analysis was not conducted. Emissions from the facility will not significantly contribute to or cause a violation of any state or federal ambient air quality standards.

The Department will issue the FINAL Permits in accordance with the conditions of the DRAFT Permits unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.

The Department will accept written comments and requests for public meetings concerning the proposed DRAFT Permits beginning on a date for a period of fourteen (14) days from the date of publication of this Notice. Written comments and requests for public meetings should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation, 6620 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station 22005, Tallahassee, Florida 32309-2400. Any written comments that will be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in this DRAFT Permit, the Department will issue a Revised DRAFT Permit and require, if applicable, another Public Notice.

(Permittees) for 157, Greenville, South Carolina (PAC) for the manufacture of two replaceable synthetic hard plates in Florida. A (Permittees) Control Technology (C-ACT) determination was not required for any air pollutants (except for the following: SO₂, PM₁₀, PM_{2.5}, and VOCs). Permitted Significant Emissions (PSEs). The units will be equipped with scrubbers that require costly air cleaning in certain covered by this notice.

Maximum particulate matter emissions from the two larger plates (two units) permitted production are estimated to be 72.4 pounds per hour (lb/hr) and 24.0 tons per year (TPY) each. Maximum particulate matter emissions from two other plates (two units) permitted production are estimated to be 0.5 pounds per hour (lb/hr) and 24.0 tons per year (TPY) each. Maximum particulate matter emissions from the two plates (two units) are estimated to be 0.5 lb/hr and 15.1 TPY. The particulates and metals will come from production from each unit. The plates will not be a source of any other air pollutants.

Because of the low emissions and the short time of operation in any one site (2 years), the emissions from these units will not cause any violation of the ambient air quality standards. An air quality impact analysis was not conducted. Emissions from the facility will not significantly contribute to or cause a violation of any state or federal ambient air quality standards.

The Department will issue the FINAL Permits, in accordance with the provisions of the DRAFT PERMITS unless a response received to accordance with the following provisions results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.

The Department will accept written comments and requests for public hearings regarding the proposed DRAFT Permit decisions within the period of time (14) days from the date of publication of this Notice. Written comments and requests for public hearings should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Protection, 3200 Blair Stone Road, Mail Stop 91206, Tallahassee, Florida 32309-3206. Any written comments that shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a published change to the DRAFT Permits, the Department shall issue a Revised DRAFT Permit and notify the Permittees. If applicable, another Public Notice.

The Department will issue the FINAL Permits with the conditions of the Draft Permits unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to Section 120.599 and 120.57 F.S. Petitions to open records for this action. The procedure for petitioning for a hearing set out below.

A person whose professional activities are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Section 120.599 and 120.57 F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department, 3200 Government Center, Tallahassee, Florida 32309-3200, telephone 904/432-7307, fax 904/432-7371. Petitions must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of receipt of the notice of intent. A petition must also include a copy of the petition to the applicant of the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition for a hearing or to appear at the hearing will constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (including a hearing) within the appropriate time period that petitioners have in this proceeding and participation of a party in it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 20.3-207 of the Florida Administrative Code.

A petition must contain the following information: (1) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner; the applicant's name and address; the Permittees' name and the county in which the project is proposed; (2) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action; (3) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action; (4) A statement of the facts that the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; (5) A statement identifying the relief sought by the petitioner; and (6) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner. The petitioner must also include a copy of the petition to the Department's action or proposed action addressed to this notice of intent.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to facilitate final agency action, the filing of a petition requires that the Department's final action may be different from the petition unless it is in this notice of intent. Petitioners whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department are encouraged to have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.


