

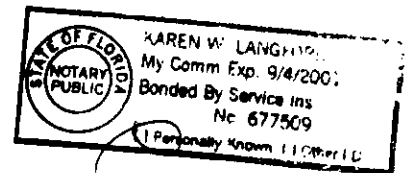

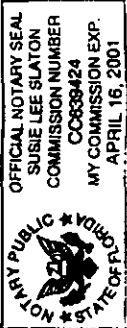

The Department will accept written comments concerning the proposed DRAFT Permits issuance actions for a period of 14 (fourteen) days from the date of publication of this Notice. Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station #2505, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400. Any written comments filed shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in these DRAFT Permits, the Department shall issue Revised DRAFT Permits and require, if applicable, another Public Notice.

The Department will issue the FINAL Permits with the conditions of the DRAFT Permits unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S. Mediation is not available for this action. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000, telephone: 850/488-9370, fax: 850/487-4938. Petitions must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of receipt of this notice of intent, whichever occurs first. A petitioner must mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition (or a request for mediation, as discussed below) within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-5.207 of the Florida Administrative Code.

A petition must contain the following information:

- The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the Permit File Numbers and the county in which the project is proposed;
- A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action;
- A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action;
- A statement of the material facts disputed by petitioner, if any;
- A statement of facts that the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action;
- A statement identifying the rules or statutes that the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and
- A statement of the relief sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the Department's action or proposed action addressed in this notice of intent.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice of intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department on
