The City of Jacksonville, Regulatory and Environmental Services Department, Air & Water Quality Division (AWQD), has determined that the operation of relocatable crushers will require an air pollution source permit.

A permit application should be submitted by April 1, 1997, for an after-the-fact construction permit to AWQD if the operation of these units are restricted to Duval County. If the units are operated in counties outside of Duval County, AWQD should be contacted for additional instructions.

An application and fee schedule are enclosed for your convenience.
