

The Department will accept written comments concerning the proposed DRAFT Permit Issuance actions for a period of 14 (fourteen) days from the date of publication of this Notice. Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of air Regulation, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mati Station #5505, Tatlahassee, Florida 32399-2400. Any written comments filled shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in this DRAFT Permit; the Department shall issue a Revised DRAFT Permit and require, if applicable, another Public Notice

The Department will issue the FINAL Permit with the conditions of the DRAFT Permit unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filled pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. Mediation is not available for this proposed action. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below. 4

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) in accordance with Section 120.569 and 120.57, ES.
