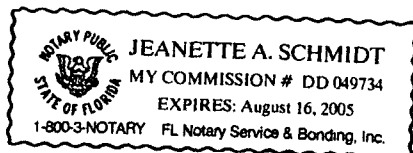

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE AIR CONSTRUCTION PERMIT

The Department of Environmental Protection gives notice of its intent to issue an air construction permit (Permit No. 775176-001-AC) to C.W. Roberts Contracting, Inc., for the construction of a relocatable asphalt plant. The plant will be initially constructed at County Road 114, 0.2 miles east of Start Road 35, Wildwood, Sumter County, FL 34785. The plant may be moved to other Sites in Florida upon additional public notice as specified within the draft permit.

The facility has been reviewed for potential operation in all counties in Florida. Emissions during operation of the asphalt concrete plant will be controlled by a baghouse. The asphalt concrete plant is allowed to process at a maximum rate of 400 tons per hour. The asphalt plant is allowed to operate continuously, i.e., 8,760 hours year and the total material that can be processed is 590,000 tons of asphalt per calendar year. Because of low emissions and limited time of operation at any one site, the facility will not cause or contribute to any violation of an ambient air quality standard. The applicant's name and address are: C.W. Roberts Contracting, Inc., Hwy 20 East, Hosford, FL 32334, Attention: Mr Charles W Roberts, President.

The Department will issue the permit with the attached conditions unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., before the deadline for filing a petition. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-3000. Petitions filed by the permit applicant or any of the parties listed below must be filed within fourteen days of receipt of this notice of intent. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120.60(3), F.S., must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of receipt of this notice of intent, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however, any person who asked the Department for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205, F.A.C. A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Department's action is based must contain the following information:

(a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known.
(b) The name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner, the name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the petitioner's substantial interests will be affected by the

agency determination.

(c) A statement of how and when petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed action.

(d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact, if there are none, the petition must so indicate.

(e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's action; and

(f) A statement of specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; and

(g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Department's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this permit. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation is not available in this proceeding.

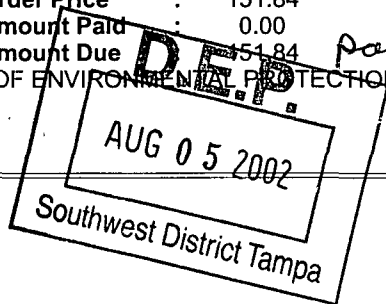

Additionally, the Department will accept written comments concerning the proposed permit issuance action for a period of 14 (fourteen) days from the date of publication of "Public Notice of Intent to Issue Permit." Requests and written comments filed should be provided to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection at 3804 Coconut Palm Drive, Tampa, FL 33619 to the attention of Mr. David Zell (phone no. 813-744-6100 ext. 107) referencing Permit File No. 7775176-001-AC. Any written comments filed shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in the proposed agency action, the Department shall revise the draft permit and require, if applicable, another Public Notice.
