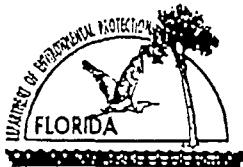

Approximately 350 people in our neighborhood signed the enclosed petition opposing the proposed asphalt company. We are concerned that this would be hazardous material, that it would be detrimental to children and the elderly living in the area, and that our property values would plummet.

We request that an administrative hearing take place and that this permit **not** be issued.



- B) See petitions enclosed. 350 people with their names, addresses and phone numbers are on the petitions. Our interests will be affected due to the dust from asphalt trucks moving about the property, the trucks transporting asphalt through our neighborhood to by-pass the city of Wildwood, the noise from the plant and trucks, and the possibility of malfunctioning equipment that would put our people at risk, especially the elderly and children. Additional concerns are: Impacts of fugitive particulate matter on people, houses, trees, shrubs, flora, and pets; and concern for the pollutants coming from the exhaust stack.
- C) The only notice that I'm aware of was in the Sumter County Times August 1, 2002. That article has been included in this packet. Most of the people in our area were totally unaware that this was taking place. I received e-mail copies of the application etc on August 5, 2002.
