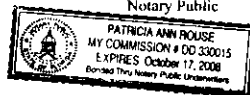

The Department of Environmental Protection (permitting authority) gives notice of its intent to issue an Air Construction Permit to The Lane Construction Corporation for a 200 ton-hour mobile air compressor at the proposed construction site located at 13833 Howard Blvd., Unit 100, Lakeland, Polk County, Florida. The permitting authority has determined that the proposed construction project meets the requirements of Chapter 403 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) Chapter 62-10.00 and 62-210.00. Pursuant to Sections 403.915 and 403.987, F.S., and Rules 62-10.00 and 62-210.00, F.A.C., you (the applicant) are required to publish this notice in the enclosed PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE AN AIR CONSTRUCTION PERMIT. The notice shall be published one time only in the legal advertisement section of a newspaper of general circulation in the county where the activity is to take place. If you are uncertain that a newspaper meets the requirements, please contact the permitting authority at the address or telephone number below. The applicant shall provide proof of publication to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation at 2000 New Stone Road, Mail Station 8505, Tallahassee, Florida 32309-2400 (Telephone: 850/922-4970) within 7 (seven) days of publication. Failure to publish the notice and proof of publication may result in the denial of the permit pursuant to 62-10.00, F.A.C. and 62-210.00, F.A.C.

The permitting authority will issue the final Air Construction Permit unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms of conditions. If the permitting authority receives written comments concerning the proposed permit action for a period of 14 (fourteen) days from the date of publication of PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE AN AIR CONSTRUCTION PERMIT, written comments should be provided to the permitting authority at the address or telephone number below. If applicable, another Public Notice of Intent to Issue an Air Construction Permit may be required. A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permit action must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of the Council of the Department, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 856, Tallahassee, Florida 32309-2201 (Telephone: 850/245-2241; Fax: 850/245-2203). Petitions filed by the permit applicant or by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120.50(3), F.S., must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of receipt of notice, whichever occurs first, under Section 120.50(3), F.S. However, any person who is not entitled to written notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of the date of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.571, F.S., or to intervene in the proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only of the nature of a motion filed with the permitting authority in accordance with Rule 28-106.205, F.A.C.

A petitioner must contain the following information:

- The name and address of each petitioner; the applicant's name and address; the name and the county in which the project is proposed;
- A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the permit action or proposed action;
- A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the permitting authority's action or proposed action;
- A statement of the material facts disputed by the petitioner, if any;
- A statement of the facts that the petitioner contends warrant a modification of the permitting authority's action or proposed action; and
- A statement identifying the rules or statutes that the petitioner contends require a modification of the permitting authority's action or proposed action; and
- A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action the petitioner wants the permitting authority to take with respect to the action or proposed action in the notice of intent.

A person that does not dispute the material facts upon which the permitting authority's action or proposed action is based shall not be a party to the proceeding. A person who does not dispute the material facts as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C., shall not be a party to the proceeding. Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, a person means that the permitting authority's final action may be different from the position in the notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision by the permitting authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation is not available in this proceeding.
