Dear Mr. De La Garza:

On October 12, 2006, the Department received your application for an air construction permit for authorization to build/assemble a portable transloader operation (PTO) to operate in several counties in Florida; and, on November 27, 2006, a letter was received depicting the initial locations that the PTO is planned to be operated. The application package is considered to be incomplete. In order to continue processing your application, the Department will need the additional information requested below. Should your response to any of the items below require new calculations, please submit the new calculations, assumptions, reference material and appropriate revised pages of the application form.

1. In the application, Section D., Emissions Unit Pollutant Detail Information, specifically for PM/PM₁₀, the emission factor (EF) as well as the requested allowable limit was stated as 0.02 gr/cf, yet the calculations for the potential-to-emit (PTE) was based on 0.01 gr/cf. Please correct and resubmit. Also, provide documentation for the EF. What is the basis for the requested allowable limit?
2. If any response to the above issues affect the application submittal, including attachments and supporting documents, please correct and/or change the application, including attachments and supporting documents, to reflect the corrections and/or changes and submit.

The Department will resume processing your application after receipt of the requested information. Rule 62-4.050(3), F.A.C., requires that all applications for a Department permit must be certified by a professional engineer registered in the State of Florida. This requirement also applies to responses to Department requests for additional information of an engineering nature. For any material changes to the application, please include a new certification statement by the authorized representative or responsible official. You are reminded that Rule 62-4.055(1), F.A.C. requires applicants to respond to requests for information within 90 days or provide a written request for an additional period of time to submit the information.
