Facility Location: Florida Power & Light Company operates the existing Cape Canaveral Plant, which is located in Brevard

County at 6000 N. US bighway No. 1, Cocoa, FL, 32927.

Project: The applicant has submitted a complete and certified Clean Air Interstate Rule (CAIR) Part Form and has requested its incorporation into the existing Title V air operation permit. This facility consists of two oil and natural gas fired conventional steam electric generating stations, designated as Units #1 2nd.

#2. Each steam unit is a nominal 400 megawatt (MW) class (electric) steam generator which drives a single reheat turbine generator.

Based on the Title V permit renewal application received on July 1, 2004, this facility is a major source of hazardous air pollutants (HAP).

Permitting Authority: Applications for Title V air operation permits are sublect to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Chapters 82-4, 82-210, 62-213 and 62-296,470 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).
