Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) is submitting this notification in accordance with 40 CFR Part 60 & 75. Indicated below are the estimated dates for Performance Testing and Continuous Emission Monitoring (CEM) Certification for Cape Canaveral Energy Center (CCEC) Unit 3. FPL would also like to provide notice that the estimated date of first fire of Unit 3 using oil is not expected until October of 2013.

Included in this submittal are the CEMS Certification Protocol and the Initial Monitoring Plan as required by Rule 40 CFR Part 75.
