Enclosed is Permit Number A005-176351, dated (0-4-5), to change the permit conditions, issued pursuant to Section 403.087, Florida Statutes.

persons whose substantial interests are affected by this permit have a right, pursuant to Section 120.57, Florida Statutes, to petition for an administrative determination (hearing), unless the right to petition has been waived. The petition must conform to the requirements of Chapters 17-103 F.A.C., and must be filed (received) in the Department's Office of General Counsel, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee 32399-2400, within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this notice. Failure to file a petition within that time constitutes a waiver of any right such person has to an administrative determination pursuant to Section 120.57, Florida Statutes.

The petition shall contain the following information; (a) the name, address and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the Department Permit File Number and the county in which the project is proposed; (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the department's action or proposed action; (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the department's action or proposed action; (d) A statement of the material facts disputed by Petitioner, if any; (e) A statement of facts which petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the department's action or proposed action; (f) A statement of which rules or statutes petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the department's action or proposed action; and (g) A statement of the relief sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wants the department to take with respect to the department's action or proposed action.

This Order (Permit) is final and effective on the date filed with the Clerk of the Department unless a petition is filed in accordance with the above paragraph. Upon the timely filing of a petition this Permit will not be effective until further Order of the Department.

Any party to the Order has the right to seek judicial review of the Order pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, by the filing of a Notice of Appeal pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the Department in the Office of General Counsel, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400; and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate district Court of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days from the date the Final Order is filed with the Clerk of the Department.

This permit is issued under the provisions of Chapter(s) 403, Florida Statutes, and Florida Administrative Code Rule(s) 17-2. The above named permittee is hereby authorized to perform the work or operate the facility shown on the application and approved drawing(s), plans, and other documents attached hereto or on file with the department and made a part hereof and specifically described as follows:

The permittee can operate Combustion Turbines CT-A and CT-B. Each is a simple cycle GE Frame 6 combustion turbine, with about 35 MW capacity. The turbines will primarily fire natural gas. Distillate oil will be fired during periods of curtailed or uneconomical natural gas supply. Nitrogen oxide emissions will be controlled by water injection.

These sources are located at the Indian River Plant in Brevard County, Florida.

General Conditions are attached to be distributed to the permittee only.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

16. This permit does not preclude compliance with any applicable local permitting requirements and regulations.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:

OPERATING LIMITS

- 1. Each turbine may operate continuously (8,760 hrs/year).
- 2. Only natural gas or distillate oil shall be fired in the turbines.
- 3. The maximum heat input to each turbine shall not exceed 445 MMBTU/hr, at sea level and 59°F (see OUC's August 17, 1988 letter and Attachment 13 for a plot of heat input vs. temperature).
- 4. Any change in the method of operation, fuels, equipment or operating hours shall be submitted for approval to the Central District Office.
- 5. Both start and black start capability shall be provided by a No. 2 fuel oil fired 800 HP internal combustion diesel (for each turbine), projected to run for approximately 10 minutes per start. These diesels are expected to emit minimal air emissions (15 lbs SO2 yr/unit).

6. The maximum allowable emissions from the turbine(s) in accordance with the BACT determination, shall not exceed the following, at sea level and 59°F:

9. The distillate oil sulfur content shall not exceed 0.3% by weight.

COMPLIANCE TESTING

- 10. Annual compliance tests shall be performed with the fuel(s) used for more than 170 hours in the preceding 12 month period. Tests shall be conducted using EPA methods in accordance with the July 1, 1987 version of 40 CFR 60 Appendix A:
 - a. 20 for NOx
 - b. ASTM D 2880-71 for sulfur content of distillate oil
 - c. 9 for VE

Compliance with SO_2 limits may be demonstrated by testing all oil shipments for sulfur content less than 0.30 percent using ASTM D 2880-71.

Any unit which has accumulated 170 hours burning fuel oil during the preceding 12 month period shall conduct an annual test using fuel oil.

Other DER approved methods may be used for compliance testing after prior Departmental approval.

- 11. The required compliance tests shall be conducted at yearly intervals from the date of January 20, 1990.
- 12. The project shall comply with all the applicable requirements of Chapter 17-2, Florida Administrative Code and the July 1, 1987 version of 40 CFR 60 Subpart GG, Gas Turbines.

13. This office (Florida Department of Environmental Regulation, Air Permitting, Orlando) shall be notified at least fifteen (15) days in advance of the compliance tests so that we can witness them (Rule 17-2.700(2)(a)5, P.A.C.).

- 14. This plant is required to operate within 90 to 100 percent of permitted capacity during the compliance tests.
- 15. The required test report shall be filed with the department as soon as practical but no later than 45 days after the last sampling run of each test is completed (Rule 17-2.700(7)(a),(b) and (c), F.A.C).
- 16. Water injection shall be continuously monitored for NOx control at the following one-hour average minimum water to fuel weight ratio.
