Facility Location: The applican'i operates the existing Indian River Plant, which is jocated in Brevard County at US 1 & nd Kings Highway in Titusville, Florida.

Project: The applican'i applied on May 21, 2009, to the Department for a Title V air operation permit renewal. This is a renewal of Title V air operation permit No. 009 0008-003-AV. The existing facility' consists primarily of four combustion turbines. En: Issions units 004 and 007 (combustion furbines A and B) consist of simple cycle Genera. Electric Frame 6 combustion turbines, each with a 35 megawart (MW) rating. Although the furbines primarily fire natural gas, distillate of may be fired during periods of curtailled or uneconomical natural gas supply. Nitrogen oxides emissions are reduced by using water injection. Both furbines began commercial operation on August 1, 1990.

Emissions units 005 and 004 (combustion turbines C and D) consists of simple cycle. Westinghouse Model, Number 501-D5 combustion turbines, each with a 199 MW rating. The furbines orimarily fire natural gas. Distillate oil may be fired during periods of curtailed or uneconomical injudical permits on November 1, 1991.

Parmitting Authority: Applications for Tifle V air operation permits for facilities that operate Acid Ratin units are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Chapters 62-4, 62-210, 62-213 and 69-714, of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The proposed project is not exempt from air permiting requirements and a Title V air operation permit is required to operate the facility. The Bureau of Air Regulation is the Permitting Authority responsible for making a permit determination for this project.
