Facility Location The applicant operates the existing NGS/SJRPP/ST Facility, which is located in Duval County at , 4377 Heckshire Drive, Jacksonville, Florida.

Project: The applicant applied on August 10, 2009; to the Department for an air construction permit and a revision of Title V air operation permit No. 0310045-020-AV. The air construction permit authorizes the combustion of landfill gas, in the Circulating Fluidized Bed Boiler (CFB) Nos. 1 and 2 at the Northside Generating Station. The Title V air operation permit revision incorporates applicable specific terms and conditions from previously issued air construction permits. The existing facility consists of JEA's Northside Generating Station and St. Johns River Power Park facility and the Separation Technologies LLC's Separation Technologies, Inc. fly ash processing system.

Permitting Authority Applications for air construction permits are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Chapters 62-4, 62-210 and 62-212 of the Florida Administrative Code; (F.A.C.). The proposed project is not exempt from air permitting requirements and an air permit is required to perform the proposed work. The Bureau of Air Regulation is the Permitting Authority responsible for making a permit determination for this project.

Comments: The Permitting Authority will accept written comments concerning the draft air construction permitting a period of 14 days from the date of publication of the Public Notice. Written comments must be received by the Permitting Authority by close of business (5:00 p.m.) on or before the end of this 14-day period. If written comments received result in a significant change to the draft air construction permit, the Permitting Authority shall revise the draft air construction permit and require, if applicable, another Public Notice. All comments filed will be made available for public inspection. available for public inspection.

The Permitting Authority will accept written comments concerning the draft/proposed Title V air operation permit revision for a period of 30 days from the date of publication of the Public Notice. Written comments must be received by the close of business (5:00 p.m.), on or before the end of this 30-day period by the Permitting Authority at the above address. As part of his or her comments, any person may also request that the Permitting Authority hold a public meeting on this permitting action. If the Permitting Authority determines there is sufficient interest for a public meeting, it will publish notice of the time, date, and location in the Florida Administrative Weekly (FAW). If a public meeting is requested within the 30-day comment period and conducted by the Permitting Authority, any oral and meeting is requested within the 30-day comment period and conducted by the Permitting Authority. If timely written comments received during the public meeting will also be considered by the Permitting Authority. Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Permitting Authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Permitting Authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation: Mediation is not available for this proceeding.

EPA Review: EPA has agreed to treat the draft/proposed Title V air operation permit revision as a proposed Title V air operation permit revision and to perform its 45-day review provided by the law and regulations concurrently with the public comment period. Although EPA's 45-day review period will be performed concurrently with the public comment period, the deadline for submitting a citizen petition to object to the EPA Administrator will be determined as if EPA's 45-day review period is performed after the public comment period has ended. Section 7661d(b)(1), to object to the issuance of any Title V. air operation permit. Any petition shall be based only on objections to the permit that were raised with reasonable specificity during the 30-day public comment period provided in the Public Notice, unless the petitioner demonstrates to the Administrator of the EPA that it was period provided to raise such objections within the comment period or unless the grounds for such objection arose affeit impracticable to raise such objections within the Administrator of the EPA does not stay the effective date of any the comment period.
