On February 24, 2006 Trail Ridge Energy, LLC applied for a PSD air construction permit for six internal combustion engines to burn landfill gas at the Trail Ridge Landfill. This application was submitted to the FDEP office in Tallahasse for processing.

On March 21, 2006 Trail Ridge Landfill, Inc. applied for an air construction permit for a new, larger replacement flare to burn landfill gas at the Trail Ridge Landfill. This application was submitted to the Environmental Quality Division (EQD) office for processing.

Syed Arif, P.E., FDEP permit engineer and I (Jerry Woosley) have coordinated concerning these applications, which are both currently incomplete. By copy of the attached e-mail, Mr. Arif has requested that our office (EQD) process the flare application. Mr. Arif will handle all PSD issues concerning these projects in the PSD permit which he is processing.

Based on our conversation earlier I would appreciate if you can process the flare application. Waste Management had indicated that they were not aware of the Engine installation project at the Landfill. The flare application was submitted to be in compliance with the NSPS requirements of controlling additional landfill gas that they had started collecting in February. The new flare has to be in place by end of June. I have asked Waste Management to satisfactorily respond to your RAI's so that the flare permit can be issued in time to comply with the NSPS requirements. We have in our PSD project considered the modeling aspect of the additional CO emissions from the new flare. Thanks for your help on this. Call me if you have any questions.
