The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (permitting authority) gives notice of its intent to issue a Title V Air Operation Permit Revision to JEA for their Brandy Branch Generating Station located in Baldwin City, Duval County. The applicant's name and address are: JEA, James M. Chansler, Vice President; 21 West Church Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32202-3139.

The permit revision incorporates the recent conversion to combined cycle of two combustion turbines. The permitting authority will issue the PROPOSED Permit, and subsequent FINAL Permit, in accordance with the conditions of the DRAFT Permit unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.

The permitting authority will accept written comments concerning the proposed DRAFT Permit issuance action for a period of 30 (thirty) days from the date of publication of this Notice. Written comments should be provided to the Department. Any written comments filled shall be made available for public inspection. As part of his or her comments, any person may also request that the Permitting Authority hold a public meeting on this permitting action. If the Permitting Authority determines there is sufficient interest for a public meeting, it will publish notice of the time, date, and location on the Department's official web site for notices (http://flhora6.dep.state.fl.us/onw/) and in a newspaper of general circulation in the area affected by the permitting action. If written comments received result in a significant change in this DRAFT Permit, the permitting authority shall issue a Revised DRAFT Permit and require, if applicable, another Public Notice.
