On May 2nd, Dave Buff called me back regarding my email from last Friday. We discussed the following items:

The two diesel generators at the Clewiston Mill are gone.

- Most of the raw sugar produced at Bryant is shipped to Clewiston for processing. Some is currently sent to a sugar refinery in Savannah, GA.
- Soon, all of the raw sugar produced at Bryant is shipped to Clewiston for processing.
- They are building an electrically-powered sugar mill. It should be listed as an insignificant unit. He will get me a general description.
- MACT: HCl by stack test; PM as surrogate for TSM except manganese; manganese by risk assessment; and mercury by fuel analysis.
- Will be requesting Boiler 8 steam production increase and biomass handling modification.
- Briefly discussed CAM for SO2 limits. He mentioned the Okeelanta cogeneration units use dry cyclones and a dry ESP and can still meet 0.06 lb/MMBtu on an annual average basis (also fire wood).
- Discussed current problems with wet scrubber on new sugar dryer.
- Agreed to discuss more later, including Okeelanta.
