- 2. Startup: Please submit some operational data during a long startup indicating: load, oxygen, ammonia injection rate, and CO/NOx emissions. Are there "hot" startups and "cold" startups?
- 3. Please identify the problems with the installed baghouses and provide additional details on the physical changes to the existing conveyor system. Define "bagacillo". What does the bagacillo cyclone control? Provide additional details on the design of the bagacillo cyclone. Is there vendor information to support > 99.99% control?
