On or about February 7, 2008, United States Sugar Corporation received notice of publication of the Public Notice of Intent to Issue Title V Air Operation Permit Renewal and Concurrent Air Construction Permit Revision for the Clewiston Sugar Mill and Refinery. United States Sugar has not yet published the notice in the local newspaper. 
