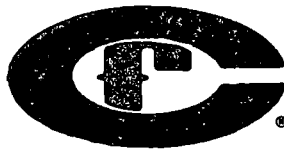

NOTICE OF INTENT
TO ISSUE

The Department of Environ-
mental Regulation gives notice
of its intent to issue a con-
struction/modification permit
(No. AC 29-186931) for Sulfuric
Acid Plants "C" and "D" to in-
crease their production capaci-

ty from 2400 tons/day per
plant to 2600 tons/day 100%
sulfuric acid per plant at the
CF Industries Plant City
Phosphate Complex, P.O.
Drawer L, Plant City, FL
33566. A determination of Best
Available Control Technology
(BACT) was required. The pro-
posed project is subject to Pre-
vention of Significant
Deterioration (PSD) regula-
tions. For sulfur dioxide and
nitrogen oxides, the maximum
concentrations due to the CF
Industries complex and other
sources are predicted to be
below the AAQS and PSD
Class I increments. Class I sul-
fur dioxide PSD increment con-
sumption is 1.44 vs. 2.0 ug/m3
allowable annual average, 12.7
vs. 25 ug/m3 allowable 3-hr
average, and 3.6 vs. 5 ug/m3
allowable 24-hr average. The
Class I nitrogen oxides PSD
increment consumption for
the CF Industries complex is
less than 0.04 vs. 2.5 ug/m3 al-
lowable annual average.
These emissions are not ex-
pected to cause or contribute
to a violation of any ambient
air quality standard (AAQS).
The Department is issuing this
intent to issue for the reasons
stated in the Technical Evalua-
tion and Preliminary Determi-
nation.

A person whose substantial
interests are affected by this
proposed permitting decision
may petition for an adminis-
trative proceeding (hearing) in
accordance with Section
120.57, Florida Statutes. The
petition must contain the infor-
mation set forth below and
must be filed (received) in the
Office of General Counsel of
the Department at 2600 Blair
Stone Road, Tallahassee, Flori-
da 32399-2400, within 14 days
of receipt of this intent.
Petitions filed by other per-
sons must be filed within 14
days of publication of the pub-
lic notice or within 14 days of
their receipt of this intent,
whichever first occurs.
Petitioner shall mail a copy of
the petition to the applicant at
the address indicated above
at the time of filing. Failure to
file a petition within this time
period shall constitute a waver
of any right such person
may have to request an ad-

Administrative determination
(hearing) under Section 120.57,
Florida Statutes.
The petition shall contain
the following information, and
telephone number of each
petitioner, the applicant's
name and address, the Depart-
ment Permit File Number and
the county in which the pro-
posed action is located;
(b) A statement of how and
when each petitioner received
notice of the Department's ac-
tion or proposed action;
(c) A statement of how each
petitioner's substantial
interests are affected by the
Department's action or pro-
posed action;
(d) A statement of the mate-
rial facts disputed by
Petitioner, if any;
(e) A statement of facts
which petitioner contends
warrant reversal or modifica-
tion of the Department's ac-
tion or proposed action;
(f) A statement of which
rules or statutes petitioner
contends require reversal or
modification of the Depart-
ment's action or proposed ac-
tion; and
(g) A statement of the relief
sought by petitioner, stating
precisely the action petitioner
wants the Department to take
with respect to the Depart-
ment's action or proposed ac-
tion.
If a petition is filed, the ad-
ministrative hearing process
is designed to formulate agen-
cy action. Accordingly, the
Department's final action may
be different from the position
taken by it in this Notice. Per-
sons whose substantial
interests will be affected by
any decision of the Depart-
ment with regard to the peti-
tion have the right to petition
to become a party to the pro-
ceeding. The petition must
conform to the requirements

specified above and be filed
(received) within 14 days of
receipt of this Notice in the
Office of General Counsel of
the Department at the address
within the above time frame
with the above information or
constitutes a waiver of any
such right such person has to
request a hearing under Sec-
tion 120.57, F.S. to this pro-
ceeding. Any subsequent inter-
vention will only be of the op-
erative of the presiding officer
upon motion to the Department.
A copy of the PSD applica-
tion is available for public in-
spection during normal busi-
ness hours, 8:30 a.m. to 5:00
p.m., Monday through Friday,
