

The Department of Environ mental Regulation hereby issue a permit to Central Phosphates, Inc., Post Office Drawer L. Plant City, Florida 33566, to construct a product cooler with associated cytrain diammonium phosphate plant at the phosphate fertiliz er facility located at 10609-Hillisborough County, Florida. Installation of the proposed cooler system will alter an ex-isting facility (Y-train DAP/MAP/GTSP plant). The installation of the cooler will not increase emissions from the plant. No prevention of siginificant deterioration increment consumption is expected. A Best Available Con-trol Technology (BACT) deter mination for the manufacture monoammonium phosphate was required. The Department is issuing this Intent to Issue for the reasons stated in the Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determi

A person whose substantial Interests are affected by the Department's proposed per-mitting decision may petition for an administrative proceed ing (hearing) in accordance with Section 120.57, Florida Statutes.
