1. Unit 4 Economizer Ash Silo

2. Unit 1-4 Fly Ash Silo

3. Unit 5 and 6 Fly Ash Silo

Visible emissions tests conducted by Tampa Electric Company during the month of November, 1988 show emissions from the Unit 1-4 Fly Ash Silo and Unit 5 and 6 Fly Ash Silo are 0%.

The Unit 4 Economizer Ash Silo has been out of operation since November 6, 1987. At this particular time the source was in compliance for visible emissions. Pursuant to Subsection 17-2.210(2)(c), F.A.C., the expiration date for this source's permit renewal is November 6, 1992.

Furthermore, based on my inspection conducted on February 23, 1989, no major on-site deficiencies were noted. In regards to fugitive emissions in the fly ash loading area observed by EPC/HC staff, the weight setting which indicates when a truck is full has been scaled back to prevent future potential overloadings.

I recommend approval to issue three RACT operating permits for the above sources. Enclosed for your review are the drafts of the proposed permits and a diskette.
