Subject: Lake County Waste-To-Energy Facility

Dear Mr. Fancy:

I would like to thank you and your staff for the time and resources at our meeting. An up-front conversation concerning the discussed environmental issues is more efficient and productive than any series of telephone conversations. The following comments are intended to confirm certain aspects of our meeting and to also inform you and your staff of our progress.

The facility will be owned and operated by Ogden Martin Systems of Lake, Inc. (OMSL), a subsidiary of Ogden Martin Systems, Inc. Under separate cover, OMSL has filed with the Florida Department of Environmental Regulations a request for permit transfer to OMSL from NRG Recovery Group. All necessary paperwork for facility operations will be submitted by OMSL. The facility includes two refuse combustion units and is rated for a maximum of 15.7 megawatts energy production, not the 12.3 MW value in my September 7, 1988 letter. This electrical production rate is associated with a nominal unit capacity of 110 million BTU per hour when firing refuse with a higher heating value of 5000 BTU/lb.

One stack containing two flues, one per unit, will be used for flue gas discharge. This stack will have a height of 199 feet or greater which agrees with your department's conclusions presented in your September 21, 1988 letter. I believe that this letter has addressed any outstanding questions. If you should have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me direct.

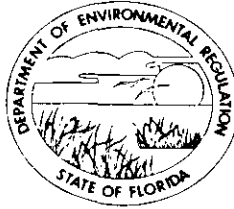
