Project This air construction permit authorizes the permanent injection of landfill leachate into the lime spray dryer absorbers (scrubbers) that are part of the air pollution control equipment of the two mass-burn municipal waste combustors (MWC) (Units 1 and 2) at the Lake County Resource Recovery Facility.

on 12/22/2011, the Department of Environmental Protection issued Covanta Lake II. Inc. Construction Permit No. 0590046-011-AC, which authorized the temporary injection of landfill leachate into the spray dryer obsorbers (scrubbers). The permittee provide the results of stack tests conducted while injecting leachate. The facility operated the leachate injection system during the 2012 annual compliance stack tests. Leachate was processed in both MWC units. There were no observable in-

onts.
Visible emissions, nitrogen oxide, sulfur dioxide and carbon monoxide from
Units 1 and 2 are measured using continuous emission monitoring and opactity systems (CEMS and COMS). Covanta will conduct the annual stack
tests for other pollutants such as hydrogen chloride, mercury, particulate
matter, metals and dioxin/furan while
injecting leachate into the scrubbers.

Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120.60(3), F.S. must be filed within 14 days of publication of this Public Notice or receipt of a written notice, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however, any person who asked the Permitting Authority for notice of agency action may file a petition within 14 days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a capy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing.
