Minor Modification to Modify the Fuel Recordkeeping Requirements and Measurement Timeframes

Dear Mr. Temples:

On February 26, 2010, the Department received a request for a minor modification to modify the fuel recordkeeping requirements and measurement timeframes for the oriented strand board (OSB) facility. Based on our review of the proposed project, we have determined that the following additional information is needed in order to continue processing this application package. Please provide all assumptions, calculations, and reference material(s), that are used or reflected in any of your responses to the following issues:

1. Provide the highest total MMBtu 30-day rolling average values for the two associated thermal oil heaters from wood firing and then from natural gas firing during the year 2009 (just looking for two values – one for wood and one for gas).

The above information is requested pursuant to the following Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) regulations: Rule 62-4.050 (Procedures to Obtain Permits and Other Authorizations; Applications); 62-4.055 (Permit Processing); 62-4.070 (Standards for Issuing or Denying Permits; Issuance; Denial); 62-4.120 (Construction Permits); 62-204.800 (Federal Regulations Adopted by Reference); 62-212.300 (Permits Required); 62-210.370 (Emissions Computations and Reporting); 62-210.900 (Forms and Instructions); 62-212.300 (General Preconstruction Review); and 62-212.400 (Prevention of Significant Deterioration). All applications for a Department permit must be certified by a professional engineer registered in the State of Florida pursuant to Rule 62-4.050(3), F.A.C. This requirement also applies to responses to Department requests for additional information of an engineering nature. For any material changes to the application, please include a new certification statement by the authorized representative or responsible official.

We will resume processing your application after receipt of the requested information. You are reminded that Rule 62-4.055(1), F.A.C. requires applicants to respond to requests for information within 90 days or to provide a written
