

The subject of the Air Construction Permit is to intially increase the facility's production from 153,205 to 162,000 oir dried metric ton (ADMI) per consecutive:12months, rolling total. After suc-cessful installation of a new blow heat recovery system to control. VOC (volatile organic compounds) emissions from all HCE (hot caus) tic extract) cells, production may increase to 175,000 ADMI per consecutive 12months, rolling total. In order to achieve the increases in production, the permittee will also be authorized to perform the following construction and work: add a new HCE washer press roll; begin first improvements to pulp machine (drying and head-box); add a new HCE evaporator train; install a new HCE blow heat recovery system to control all HCE cells; add a new HCE cell: Install a new HCE washer; begin second Improvements to pulp machine (drying and speed increase): and, install a new ost-HCE washer.
