NOTICE OF INTENT
TO ISSUE PERMIT

The Department of Environmental Protection gives notice of its intent to issue an air construction permit to Walt Disney World Company, Walt Disney World Resort to install an animal crematory at Disney's Animal Kingdom theme park, specifically the Necropay Building, to dispose of dead animals from both the theme park and from other areas within the Walt Disney World Resort property. The proposed incinerator has a capacity to process 800 pounds per 4-hour period and is a Crawford Model CB800 Animal Carcass Incinerator. The emissions unit will be fired with natural gas. The resort is located in Lake Buena Vista, Orange County, Florida. It was determined that new source review pursuant to Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) is not applicable and a Best Available Control Technology determination was not required pursuant to Rule 62-212.400, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The applicant's name and address are: Walt Disney World Co., P.O. Box 10,000, Lake Buena Vista, Florida 32830-1000.

The Department will issue the final permit, in accordance with the conditions of the Permit unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.

The Department will accept written comments concerning the proposed draft Permit issuance action for a period of fourteen (14) days from the date of publication of this Notice. Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station #5505, Tallahassee, FL 32399-2400. Any written comments filed shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in the draft Permit, the Department shall issue a Revised draft Permit, and require, if applicable, another Public Notice.

The Department will issue final Permit with the conditions of the draft Permit unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statute(s). The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below. Mediation is not available for this action.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed agency action may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Department's Office of General Counsel at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000. Petitions must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen (14) days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this notice of intent, whichever occurs first. A petitioner must mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition (or a request for mediation, as discussed below) within the applicable time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S. To intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party [b] (1) Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer, upon the filing of a motion in compliance with rule 28-5.207 of the Florida Administrative Code. A petition must contain the following information:

(a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the Permit File Number, and the county in which the project is proposed;

(b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received

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notice of the Department's action or proposed action;

(c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action;

(d) A statement of the material facts disputed by the petitioner, if any;

(e) A statement of the facts that the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action;

(f) A statement identifying the rules or statutes that the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and,

(g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action that the petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the action or proposed action addressed in this notice.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice of intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.


