PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE TITLE V AIR OPERATION PERMIT
The Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Air Regulation, is giving notice of its intent to issue a Title V Air Operation Permit for the project described below. The project is located at 1375 Buena Vista Drive, Lake Buena Vista, Orange and Osceola Counties, Florida. The applicant is Mr. Lee Schumdecker, Vice President of Walt Disney World Company, Walt Disney World Resort Complex, Orange and Osceola Counties, Florida. The applicant submitted an application for a Title V Air Operation Permit Renewal on 10/11/2007. The facility is a complex of hotels, theme parks and support facilities and air quality. The various air pollution sources are: boilers, a combined cycle combustion turbine with a natural gas-fired heat recovery steam generator, paint spray booths and associated operations, external combustion (thermal) oil heaters and hot water heaters. The Permitting Authority Applications for Title V air operation permits are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Chapters 62-47, 62-210, 62-213, and 62-214 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The proposed project is not exempt from air permitting requirements and an air permit is required to operate the facility. The Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Air Regulation, is the Permitting Authority responsible for making a permit determination regarding this project. The Permitting Authority's physical address is: 111 South Magnolia Drive, Suite 4, Tallahassee, Florida 32301. The Permitting Authority's mailing address is: 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station #5505, Tallahassee, Florida 32309-2400. The Permitting Authority's telephone number is 850/488-0714 and facsimile number is 850/921-9533. Project File: A complete project file is available for public inspection during the normal business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (except legal holidays), at address indicated above for the Permitting Authority. The complete project file includes the DRAFT/PROPOSED Permit, the Statement of Basis, the application, and the information submitted by the applicant, exclusive of confidential records under Section 403.419, F.S.; interested persons may view the DRAFT/PROPOSED Permit by visiting the following website: <http://www.dep.state.fl.us/air/products/apds/default.asp>. Notice of Intent to Issue A Permit: The Permitting Authority gives notice of its intent to issue a permit to the applicant for the project described above. The applicant has provided reasonable assurance that operation of the facility will not adversely impact air quality and that the project will comply with all appropriate provisions of Chapters 62-4, 62-204, 62-210, 62-212, 62-213, 62-214, 62-296, and 62-297, F.A.C. The Permitting Authority will issue a FINAL Permit in accordance with the conditions of the DRAFT/PROPOSED Permit unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or a significant change of terms or conditions. Comments: The Permitting Authority will accept written comments concerning the DRAFT/PROPOSED Permit for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of publication of this Public Notice. Written comments must be post-marked and all e-mail or facsimile comments must be received by the close of business (5 pm) on or before the end of this 30-day period by the Permitting Authority at the above address; e-mail or facsimile. As part of his or her comments, any person may also request that the Permitting Authority hold a public meeting on this permitting action. If the Permitting Authority determines there is sufficient interest for a public meeting, it will publish notice of the time, date, and location on the official website for notices at Florida Administrative Weekly (FAW), at <http://faw.dos.state.fl.us/> and in a newspaper of general circulation in the area affected by the permitting action. Subsequent action on the Title V and Title IV parts of the Permit Renewal may be split; if comments are received on the Title V portion of the DRAFT/PROPOSED Permit. For additional information, contact the Permitting Authority at the above address or phone number. If written comments or comments received at a public meeting result in a significant change to the DRAFT/PROPOSED Permit, the Permitting Authority shall issue a Revised DRAFT Permit and require, if applicable, another Public Notice. All

each agency's file or identification number, if known; (b) The name, address and telephone number of the petitioner; the name, address and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any; which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the petitioner's substantial rights will be affected by the agency determination; (c) A statement of how and when the petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed action; (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petitioner must so state; (e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action, including an explanation of how the alleged facts relate to specific rules or statutes; and (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action the petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action. A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Permitting Authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28.106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Permitting Authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this Public Notice of Intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Permitting Authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation: Mediation is not available for this proceeding.

EPA Review & Objections: EPA has agreed to treat the DRAFT Title V Permit as a PROPOSED Title V Permit and to perform its 45-day review provided by the law and regulations concurrently with the public comment period. Although EPA's 45-day review period will be performed concurrently with the public comment period, the deadline for submitting a citizen petition to object to the EPA Administrator will be determined as if EPA's 45-day review period is performed after the public comment period has ended. The FINAL Title V Air Operation Permit will be issued after the conclusion of the 45-day EPA review period so long as no adverse comments are received that result in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.

Finally, pursuant to 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 761d(b)(2), any person

may petition the Administrator of the EPA within sixty (60) days of the expiration of the Administrator's 45 (forty-five) day review period as established at 42 U.S.C. Section 761d(b)(1); to object to the issuance of any Title V air operation permit. Any petition shall be based only on objections to the Permit that were raised with reasonable specificity during the thirty (30) day public comment period provided in the Public Notice, unless the petitioner demonstrates to the Administrator of the EPA that it was impracticable to raise such objections within the comment period or unless the grounds for such objection arose after the comment period. Filing of a petition with the Administrator of the EPA does not stay the effective date of any permit properly issued pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 62-23, F.A.C. Petitions filed with the Administrator of EPA must meet the requirements of 42 U.S.C. Section 761d(b)(2) and must be filed with the Administrator of the EPA at: U.S. EPA, 401 M Street, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20460. 
