EPA Review: EPA has agreed to treat the DRAFT/PRO-POSED Title V air operation permit as a Proposed Title V air operation permit as a Proposed Title V air operation permit and to perform its 45-day review provided by the low and regulations concurrently with the public comment period. Although EPA's 45-day review period will be performed concurrently with the public comment period, the deadline for submitting a citizen petition to object to the EPA Administrator will be determined as if EPA's 45-day review period is performed after the public comment period is performed after the public comment period sended. The FINAL Title V air operation permit will be issued after the conclusion of the 45-day EPA review period so long as no adverse comments are received that results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.
