Dear Ms. Nelson:

The Orlando Utilities Commission (OUC) and Southern Company Services and are planning to construct, own, and operate a nominal net 285-megawatt integrated gasification combined cycle (IGCC) power plant demonstration project. The IGCC project, designated as Unit B. will be constructed on a portion of the approximately 3,280-acre site of OUC's existing Stanton Energy Center located southeast of Orlando in Orange County, Florida. Unit B will be subject to review and licensing under the Florida Electrical Power Plant Siting Act and will also require a prevention of significant deterioration permit for air emissions.

Two copies of an air quality impact analysis modeling protocol for the Stanton Energy Center Unit B project are attached for your review. Submittal of the Site Certification Application (SCA) is planned for January 2006.
