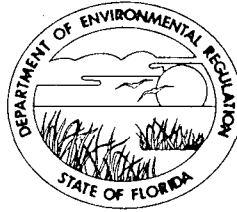

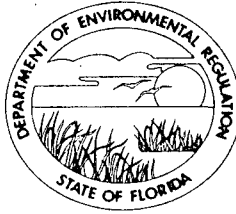

RE: Preliminary Determination - Orlando Utilities Commission
Stanton Energy Center Units 1 and 2 (PSD-FL-084)

I wish to bring to your attention that the Orlando Utilities Commission proposes to construct Units 1 and 2 of the Stanton Energy Center located approximately 10 miles southeast of Orlando, Florida, and that emissions of air pollutants will thereby be increased. The Florida Department of Environmental Regulation, under the authority delegated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, has reviewed the proposed construction under Federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration Regulations (40 CFR 52.21) and reached a preliminary determination of approval, with conditions, for this construction. This approval applies only to Federal regulatory requirements and has no bearing on other State or local functions.

Please also be aware that the attached Public Notice announcing the preliminary determination, the availability of pertinent information for public scrutiny and the opportunity for public comment will be published in a local newspaper in the near future. This notice has been mailed to you for your information and in accordance with regulatory requirements. You need take no action unless you wish to comment on the proposed construction.
