Installation of Natural Gas Igniters

This project is subject to minor source preconstruction review. Attached for your review are the following items:

- · Written Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit;
- · Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit;
- · Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination;
- · Draft Permit; and
- · P.E. Certification.

The draft permit authorizes replacement of the existing fuel oil igniter systems on Units 1 and 2 with natural gas igniter systems. The main reason for the replacement is that the use of natural gas should result in a significant cost savings over the use of oil. When the units were first built natural gas was not available to the site. Furthermore, OUC expects reduced maintenance requirements with the gas system. After gas igniters are installed on both units, fuel oil will no longer be used.

Projected significant reduction of  $NO_X$  emissions will help in future compliance with the Cross-State Air Pollution Rule. The project will also result in decreased emissions of  $SO_2$ ,

SAM, PM/PM<sub>10</sub> and CO<sub>2</sub>. Less-than-significant increases are projected in CO and VOC emissions.

We provided a copy of the draft permit, technical evaluation and public notice to David Baez of OUC Stanton Energy Center on November 14, 2011, for preliminary review and comment before issuing the draft permit. Comments were received and suggested/requested minor changes were made.
