This Title V Air Operation Permit Revision incorporates the new

method for nitrogen oxides (NCx) to continuous emissions monitors
(ICEMs) from the current water-to-fuel ratio monitoring; and, allows
the use of data obtained during the annual Relative Accuracy Test
Audit (RATA) in lieu of performing an additional Method 20 NOX
stack test.

The permiting authority will issue the PROPOSED Title V Operation Permit Revision, and subsequent FINAL Title V Operation Permit Revision in accordance with the conditions of the DRAFT Title V Operation Permit Revision unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.

The permitting authority will accept written comments concerning the proposed DRAFT Title V Operation Permit Revision Issuance action for a period of 30 (thinty) days from the date of publication of this Notice. Written comments should be provided to the Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Air Regulation, 2800 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station # 5605, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400. (Telephone: (850) 488-0114; Fax s: (850) 922-9899). Any written comments tiled shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in this DRAFT Title V Operation Permit Revision, the permitting authority shall issue a Revised DRAFT. (850) 487-4938). Petitions filled by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120,60 (3, F.S., must be filled within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of receipt of the notice of intent, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120,60 (3), F.S., however, any person who asked the permitting authority for notice of agency action may file a petition within tourteen days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the patition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the applicable time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120,569, and 120,57 F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a parry to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding authority's action is based must contain the following information:

(f) A statement of the specific rule or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the egency's proposed action; and
