

On behalf of the Florida Municipal Power Agency (FMPA) and our partners at the Kissimmee Utility Authority (KUA), I would like to invite you to tour the Cane Island Power Park, a 1,000-acre facility located near Intercession City in northwest Osceola County, Fla..

As you may be aware, FMPA and KUA recently filed a site certification application detailing their plans to expand Cane Island Power Park with one additional natural gas-fueled combined cycle generating unit. The new unit, known as Cane Island Unit 4, will provide up to 300 megawatts of electricity to 15 communities that receive all their wholesale power needs from FMPA. Those communities include the Central Florida cities of Kissimmee, Leesburg, Ocala and Bushnell, as well as Clewiston, Fort Meade, Fort Pierce, Green Cove Springs, Town of Havana, Jacksonville Beach, Key West, Lake Worth, Newberry, Starke and Vero Beach.

We understand how important it is for regulatory authorities, like you, to be well informed about projects like ours. That's why we would like to give you the opportunity to see our facility close-up and learn more about the proposed expansion.

We are hosting tours on two dates: Tuesday, April 15, from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. and Monday, April 21, from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. Please choose the date that is most convenient for you.
