Project: The applicant has submitted a complete and certified Clean Air Interstate Rule (CAIR) PA Incorporation into the existing Title V air operation permit.

This existing facility consists of two fossil fuel fired steam electric generating units, two mechanic relocatable diesel fired generators, and miscellaneous unregulated and insignificant emissions ur

Mediation: Mediation is not available for this proceeding.

EPA Review: EPA has agreed to treat the DRAFT/PROPOSED Title V air operation permit as a Prop permit and to perform its 45-day review provided by the law and regulations concurrently with th Although EPA's 45-day review period will be performed concurrently with the public comment pe submitting a citizen petition to object to the EPA Administrator will be determined as if EPA's 45- after the public comment period has ended. The FINAL Title V air operation permit will be issued day EPA review period so long as no adverse comments are received that results in a different de terms or conditions.
