

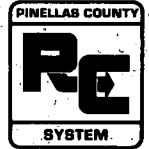

Dear Mr. Brown:

The Pinellas County Resource Recovery Facility (PCRRF) is a mass-burn waste-to-energy facility which consists of three independent units. The first two units were constructed in 1983 while the third unit was constructed in 1986. All three units were permitted under the Rules of the Florida Electrical Power Plant Siting Act (PPSA).

Attached please find a letter dated November 30, 1995, which you sent regarding Title IV acid rain permitting requirements for the facility. In accordance with your letter, please be advised that the PCRRF is not a source subject to the Acid Rain Program. The facility does not contain any acid rain units as defined at 40 CFR 73.10. Further, the facility is an exempt solid waste incinerator under Section 129(h)(4) of the Clean Air Act, 40 CFR 72.6(b)(7), and FAC 62-214.320(1)(h) because the facility units combust only municipal solid waste and do not use supplementary firing of fossil fuel of any type.

As a major Title V source, the Board of County Commissioners will be submitting a Title V operating permit application for the facility on or before June 15, 1996, in accordance with the Department's program.

Florida's Acid Rain Program has been approved by EPA. Therefore, you should mail the original and three copies of the Phase II Permit Applications and any other applicable forms such as the Repowering Extension Plan to:

Applications (Acid Rain Parts) are due no later than January 1, 1996.

In preparing the forms you should pay close attention to Chapter 62-214, F.A.C., effective July 6, 1995. Rules 62-214.310, 330 and 350 need special emphasis.

Additionally, please note the following:

- a. Forms must be submitted in four copies.
- b. Only the forms dated July 1, 1995, are acceptable.
- c. The certification statement on the form cannot be changed. It must be verbatim as printed on the form.
- d. A copy of the Certificate of Representation should be submitted pursuant to Rule 62-214.350(2), F.A.C.
- e. The form should not be altered in any way, since each condition is required by federal and state rules.



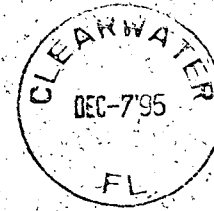
