Attached is IMCC's request to extend the above subject permits. The first two permits were issued in the Tampa Office, the third permit was issued in Tallahassee. As we discussed, the three permits should be acted on as a group and BAQM will process the request and respond to IMCC.

The permits were issued on 8/79, 1/80 and 5/80. IMCC's request would extend all three permits beyond five years. The Department appears to be reluctant to extend permits beyond five years, but I do not know of a prohibitive rule.

I recommend that the requested permit extensions be granted.

IMC, New Wales Operations, is hereby requesting an extension until December 31, 1985 on the following Construction Permits which presently expire on July 1, 1984:

8/79 AC53-19051 #3 Phosphoric Acid Plant TPA
1/20 AC53-22671 GTSP Truck/Rail Loadout TPA
5/80 AC53-23546 #2 Diammonium Phosphate Plant Tak

As previously discussed with your staff, IMC, New Wales Operations, had completed construction of the above units in late 1981. Except for mechanical checkout in November and December of 1981, these facilities have not yet been put into operation due to the economic conditions that have prevailed since then. Our present estimate is that these facilities would probably become operational in 1985.

We, therefore, request that the expiration date of the permits be modified based upon the facts presented above.

- A. Submit semi-annual reports, beginning on July 1, 1984, giving the status of the source (operational or not), any activity involving the source that occurred during the proceeding six months (scavenged components or operation of any of the source's equipment), and plans for the source during the next six months (operation or maintenance).
- B. Notify the department's Southwest District Office 30 days in advance of starting production or operations of the source.
- C. Conduct the compliance tests required by the construction permit within 45 days of placing the source in operation. Notify the District Office 10 days prior to the scheduled tests.
- D. Within 60 days after the source is placed in operation, submit copies of the compliance test reports and a complete application for a permit to operate the source to the Southwest District Office.
