ORDER CLOSING FILE

On November 29, 2007, the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (Department) issued a notice of intent to issue an air construction permit, permit number 1050059-055-AC, for the Best Available Retrofit Technology (BART) requirements to Mosaic Fertilizer, LLC (Mosaic) for its facility in Mulberry, Polk County, Florida. Mosaic filed a timely petition for formal administrative hearing (Petition) on the intended draft permit and requested the Petition be held to discuss possible resolution with the Department.

On October 3, 2008, Mosaic submitted an air construction permit to be exempted from the requirements of BART. On May 27, 2009, the Department withdrew its November 2007 intended draft permit and issued a BART exemption permit, permit no. 1050059-061-AC, to Mosaic.

There being no further matters to consider,


IT IS ORDERED:

Office of General Counsel:

Mosaic Fertilizer, LLC ("Mosaic") requests from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("FDEP") a 30 day extension of the time in which to file a petition for an administrative hearing, mediation or alternate remedies with respect to the above referenced draft permit ("Draft BART Permit").

Mosaic received the original Draft BART Permit for the New Wales Facility from the FDEP via U.S. mail on December 4, 2007. On December 10, 2007, Mosaic requested an extension of time to review the Draft BART Permit. On December 13, 2007, FDEP entered an Order granting Mosaic an extension until December 31, 2007. Despite the extension, Mosaic has not had adequate opportunity to discuss and resolve with the FDEP concerns it has with respect to the Draft BART Permit which implements a new program and applies new criteria at substantial cost. Mosaic seeks this extension so that it may have additional time to resolve with FDEP the issues regarding the Draft BART Permit. Mosaic has scheduled a meeting to discuss the issues for January 11, 2007.

While Mosaic is confident the issues can be resolved without the need for a formal proceeding, in order to fully protect and reserve its right to a hearing, mediation or other remedy, Mosaic requests this extension.

Mosaic published the Draft BART Permit on December 20, 2007 which initiated a 30 day comment period. Mosaic's requested extension of time will run concurrently with the public comment period and therefore, should not be unduly burdensome to FDEP.

Therefore, Mosaic hereby requests an extension until January 26, 2008, or such other extension period FDEP deems adequate, to provide Mosaic adequate time to review the Draft BART Permit and to provide Mosaic and FDEP a reasonable opportunity to resolve any issues with respect to the Draft BART Permit.

In the event the request is denied, Mosaic understands that it will have a period of time from the denial of approximately 10 days, in which to file a petition.

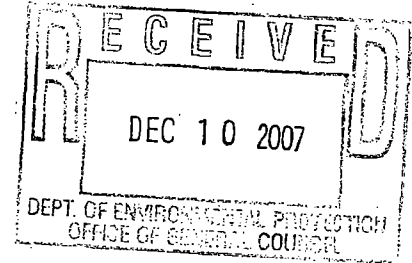
