

As you are aware, the Department and IMC Phosphates Company have been trying to resolve issues regarding hydrogen fluoride emissions in the above referenced case for nearly a year. The Department has granted IMC Phosphates Company's requests for extensions of time to file a petition for administrative hearing throughout this timeframe. The most recent extension request will expire on January 31, 2003.

While the Department remains willing to entertain settlement of these case, we do not see any reason to grant further requests for extensions of time to discuss the applicability of 40 CFR 63 Subparts AA & BB.
